

Mileage Reimbursement Guidelines

Rotation Sites that qualify for mileage reimbursement



Steps:

- 1. Allocate students to their respective cores on the master spreadsheet, considering the rural exemption status indicated in the designated columns within the spreadsheet.
- 2. Verify if the preceptor assigned to the student is eligible for mileage reimbursement.
- 3. Inform students of their rotation location through email, indicating their eligibility for mileage reimbursement.

 Additionally, instruct them to submit their forms to Clinical Administrative Support Manager Celeste Alvarez and include a map of the location.


Steps:

- 1. Allocate students to their respective cores on the master spreadsheet, considering the rural exemption status indicated in the designated columns within the spreadsheet.
- 2. Determine whether the student assigned to the preceptor is eligible for a housing stipend.

 If a student qualifies for the housing stipend, they will also qualify for the mileage reimbursement.
- 3. Notify students of rotation location via email and that they qualify for housing stipend and mileage reimbursement within four to six-weeks before the rotation start date.

Example of housing stipend & mileage reimbursement template email:


