Minimum Requirements:

The following computer specifications are the minimum requirements:

- **Processor:** Intel i5 processor or AMD Ryzen 3-5 processor
- **RAM:** 8-16GB
- **Hard Drive Space:** 256GB
- **Operating System:** Most current version of Windows or Mac OS
- **Any machine older than 2015 will NOT be supported**

Recommended Requirements:

The following computer specifications are the recommended requirements:

- **Processor:** Intel i7 or AMD Ryzen 7
- **RAM:** 8-16GB
- **Hard Drive Space:** 500GB to 1TB
- **Operating System:** Most current version of Windows or Mac OS
