#### Interpreting the Data

- The first goal of a residency application is to gain an interview, as programs at which you interview will be the programs that rank you in the Match.
- You should aim to do well in your emergency medicine core rotation as program directors will tend take this into account when considering who to invite for interview
- It is important to do well in internal medicine and surgery clinical rotations (Freeman, 2019). Aim for honors in these rotations if possible as it will enhance your application.
- Letters of recommendation are very important in emergency medicine.
  Emergency medicine uses Standardized Letters of Evaluation (SLOE) and the process for letter writers is slightly different. More information is available at www.cordem.org
- Scheduling audition electives in programs you would like to attend for residency can be a helpful approach for this specialty.
- Being able to demonstrate leadership abilities and experience in your application will be helpful as this quality is valued by program directors.
