Interpreting the Data

- General surgery is a competitive specialty which will require evidence of strong academic ability and very good board scores.
- USMLE scores are valued by program directors in general surgery and DO applicants should consider taking USMLE exams.
- Involvement in research, especially research relating to surgery, can be a helpful addition when applying general surgery program (Freeman, 2019).
- Letters of recommendation are valued highly by program directors. Applicants should have three strong letters from surgeons (Freeman, 2019).
- It is important to perform well in all core rotations. It is important to aim for an honors grade in the surgery rotation.
- As prior knowledge of the applicant is valued by program directors, it is probably advisable that you would seek to carry out audition electives at surgery programs that you are especially interested in.
- Involvement in community engagement projects that display leadership skills, the ability to work well in a team, a strong work ethic, and the ability to accomplish goals can be of benefit for applicants to general surgery programs.
