#### Interpreting the Data

- Psychiatry requires solid scores in board exams in order to be considered by program directors.
- USMLE scores are valued by program directors in anesthesiology and DO applicants should consider taking USMLE exams.
- The personal statement is a very important component of the psychiatry application. Care should be taken to convey a genuine interest in and passion for psychiatry in order to avoid any impression that psychiatry is a safety net in case other specialties do not work out. The personal statement should demonstrate qualities necessary for the specialty, such as empathy, honesty, and maturity (Freeman, 2019).
- Letters of recommendation are valued highly by program directors in psychiatry. Applicants should have at least two strong letters of recommendation from psychiatrists (Freeman, 2019).
- Applicants should aim to do well in all core rotations and try to achieve an honors grade in the psychiatry rotation.
- Applicants should seek to schedule additional psychiatry electives early in their fourth year in order to strengthen their application and secure letters of recommendation. Audition electives at programs the applicant is hoping to match into can also be helpful.
