#### UIWSOM

- (a) Access to daily confidential counseling with a dedicated UIWSOM counselor is available regularly on the Brooks campus. Services include coaching, individual and couples counseling, crisis intervention, and targeted assessment. UIWSOM's counseling staff includes a full time Behavioral Health Manager who is responsible for focusing on learners' mental wellness by overseeing mental health services and programming. In addition, an additional counselor and student interns have been added to the staff.
