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**Purpose:** The purpose of this document is to outline the procedure for post-award monitoring of progress made using funds allocated for support of research and scholarly activity.

## **Procedure:**

1) Presentation of progress made during the first half of the funding period.

- a) The awardee will present a written summary of progress and problems encountered at least one week prior to appearing before the Research and Scholarly Activity Committee (RSAC).
  - i) The applicant will present a 10 min oral summary of the project and the progress made and problems encountered so that the RSAC can determine if:
    - (1) Progress is satisfactory
    - (2) Additional resources may be necessary to overcome problems encountered.
    - (3) Progress has been marginal.
    - (4) Progress has been unsatisfactory and funding is terminated.
